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Abstract

Design and Art Studies is a new open-access, English-language journal founded by Asia Design Week in partnership with Global Open Share Publishing Pty Ltd. 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This journal was founded by Asia Design Week, in partnership with the international academic publishing platform Global Open Share Publishing Pty Ltd.
